PLACEMENT IN ENGLISH 102: Students who have taken either of the AP English Exams and achieved a score of 3 or better will receive credit for ENGL 101 and should be placed in 102.

Students who have an **ACT of 25/SAT 660 (Old) 1210 (New) or above** in English have the option of taking the English 101 Proficiency Test, administered by the Division of Humanities. This test may be taken in the Division office at any time, although students should allow at least one hour to complete it.

Students who demonstrate a mastery of the skills taught in ENGL 101 will be eligible for placement in ENGL 102.

The **West Virginia General Summative Assessment** achievement level score of **Level 3** is required on the mathematics and the English/language portions of the statewide eleventh grade student assessment are eligible for placement in college level courses in both content areas.
