

CONCORD UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

2016-2017 Academic Year Scholarships

Students must complete the process of admission and be admitted to Concord University. All institutional and foundation scholarships are contingent upon available funds and awarded on a first come, first served basis.

Tier one (1) Renewable

Recipient should have 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 18-20; SAT 870-950**

Amount: In-State: \$2,000 Out-of-State: \$1,000

Tier two (2) Renewable

Recipient should have 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 21-24; SAT 960-1130**

Amount: In-State: \$2,500 Out-of-State: \$2,000

Tier three (3) Renewable

Recipient should have 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 25-36; SAT 1140-1600**

Amount: In-State: \$2,750 Out-of-State: \$3,000

Tier four (4) Renewable

Recipient should have 3.5 cumulative GPA and ACT 26-36; SAT 1170-1600** - Tier three (3) Scholarship and Tier four (4) Scholarship will not be combined.

Amount: In-State: \$4,000 plus \$2,000 Residential Scholarship, if applicable.

Out-of-State: \$4,000 plus \$2,000 Residential Scholarship, if applicable.

ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Transfer Scholarship

Recipient must have a 2.75 transferable college or university cumulative GPA

Amount: \$1,000 (Renewable)

Boy's and Girl's State

Recipient must have attended his or her state's American Legion Boy's or Girl's State camp - program

Amount: \$500 (Non-renewable)

Performing Arts

Recipient participating in the Concord University Fine Arts Programs including instrumental, vocal and theater (contact the Division of Fine Arts - open to all majors). Recipient must maintain good academic standing for renewal

Amount: Varies

Hugh O'Brian

Recipient must have attended the Hugh O'Brian Youth Foundation camp - program

Amount: \$500 (Non-renewable)

Bonner Scholar

Recipient involved in community service, awarded by the Bonner Scholars program (separate application - open to all majors) February 1 deadline. Recipient must maintain good academic standing for renewal

Amount: \$2,500

Foundation

Recipient must meet criteria established through the Concord University Foundation and complete Concord University's Foundation Scholarship Application (separate application-open to current students as well)

Amount: Varies

Legacy Scholarship

Recipient must be a dependant of a CC or CU graduate and have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 18 or SAT 870**. Transfer recipient must have a 2.75 transferable college or university cumulative GPA.

Amount: \$1,000 (Non-renewable)

****Combined critical reading and mathematics score only**

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

Concord University tier scholarships are awarded to first-time freshmen. For additional scholarships, students must meet established criteria to be awarded. All incoming freshmen, transfers, re-admit and current students may apply for Concord University Foundation Scholarships. All institutional and foundation scholarships are contingent upon available funds and awarded on a first come, first served basis.

SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL

Recipients must maintain fulltime enrollment and maintain a minimum 3.0 Concord University cumulative GPA. Renewable scholarships are awarded for eight consecutive semesters.
