**All unmarried, traditional age students (freshmen, sophomore, junior, and senior) who do not commute, and reside with their immediate family, are required to reside on campus in the University's residence halls so long as space is available.**

**Please note: If you possess a Concord University Scholarship of distinction (Presidential or Dean Scholarships), or are a McKelvey Scholarship recipient, or have earned one of the Out of State Tuition Reduction Scholarships (border county, parents who are teachers, selected majors), you may forfeit all, or a portion of your scholarship, by moving off-campus for any reason.**

**In addition, if you are a Concord University student athlete on athletic scholarship, you are required to discuss the possibility of moving off-campus with your specific Head Coach, prior to application submission. Most athletic scholarships are structured to contain room and board waivers. Room and Board waivers are a granted privilege that allows the student athlete not to pay a room and board fee, or a portion of the room and board fee, and waivers do not juxtapose to dollars which can then be used off-campus for rent or food. Therefore, moving off-campus could mean a decrease (for some a significant decrease) of the dollar value portion of your overall athletic scholarship.**
