Recipient should have a 3.75 cumulative GPA and ACT 28 or SAT 1240\*\* or higher and recipient must reside in college housing.

**Presidential\***

The Presidential Scholarship will cover full tuition, mandatory fees\*\*\*, room and board. West Virginia PROMISE Scholar recipients must apply their scholarship towards tuition and fees. Recipient will have one trip abroad with the Concord University Honors Program and gain acceptance into the Honors Program.

**Dean's\***

The Dean's Scholarship will cover full tuition, mandatory fees\*\*\*, room and board. West Virginia PROMISE Scholar recipients must apply their scholarship towards tuition and fees. Recipient will gain acceptance into the Concord University Honors Program.

**Marsh\***

- In-State Value \$5,000
- Out-of-State Value \$8,000

**Board of Governors\***

- In-State Value \$2,000 – \$5,000
- Out-of-State Value \$2,000 - \$8,000

# Concord University Scholarship Program

### Tier one (1) Non-renewable

Recipient should have 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 18-20; SAT 870-950\*\*

**Amount In-State: Up To \$750**

**Out-of-State: Up To \$750**

### Tier two (2) Renewable

Recipient should have 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 21-24; SAT 960-1130\*\*

**Amount: In-State: Up To \$1,000**

**Out-of-State: Up To \$2,000**

### Tier three (3) Renewable

Recipient should have 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 25-36; SAT 1140-1600\*\*

**Amount: In-State: Up To \$2,000**

**Out-of-State: Up To \$3,000**



To be eligible for the Concord University Tier Scholarship and Additional Scholarships, students must complete the process of admission, be granted acceptance, have a current scholarship application on file, and meet the Tier criteria by **April 15, 2012.**

## ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

### Transfer Scholarship

Recipient must have a 3.0 transferable college or university GPA

**Amount: \$500 (Renewable)**

### Advanced Placement

Recipient must provide an advanced placement score of 3 or better  
**Amount: Varies (Non-renewable - one scholarship per student)**

### Concord University Book Voucher Award

Recipient must have attended the Book Award program

**Amount: \$500 (Non-renewable)**

### Summer Academy Scholar

Recipient must have attended the Concord University Summer Academy

**Amount: \$500 (Non-renewable)**

### Boy's and Girl's State

Recipient must have attended his or her state's American Legion Boy's or Girl's State camp

**Amount: \$500 (Non-renewable)**

### Performing Arts

For students participating in the Fine Arts Programs including instrumental, vocal and theater (contact the Division of Fine Arts - Open to all majors). Student must maintain good academic standing to renew the scholarship

**Amount: Varies**

### Hugh O'Brian

Recipient must have attended the Hugh O'Brian Youth Foundation camp

**Amount: \$500 (Non-renewable)**

### Bonner Scholar

For students interested in community service, awarded by the Bonner Scholars program (separate application - open to all majors) February 1 deadline. Student must maintain good academic standing to renew the scholarship

**Amount: \$2,100**

### Foundation

Recipient must meet criteria established through the Concord University Foundation and must complete Concord University's Scholarship Application

**Amount: Varies**

### Legacy Scholarship

Recipient must be a dependant of either a CC or CU graduate and must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and ACT 18 or SAT 870\*\*

**Amount: \$1,000 (Non-renewable)**

\*\*Combined critical reading and mathematics score



## HOW TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

### STEP 1

Students must complete the process of admission and be granted acceptance to Concord University.

### STEP 2

Complete the Concord University Scholarship Application by **April 15, 2012.**

## ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

Concord University tier scholarships are awarded to first-time freshmen. For additional scholarships, students must meet established criteria to be awarded. All incoming freshmen, transfers, re-admits and current students may apply for Concord University Foundation Scholarships. All institutional and foundation scholarships are contingent upon available funds and awarded on a first come, first served basis.

## SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL

Recipients must maintain fulltime enrollment and maintain a minimum 3.0 Concord University cumulative GPA. The Scholars of Distinction scholarships (Presidential, Dean's, Marsh and Board of Governors) requires a 3.2 Concord University cumulative GPA and reside in college housing. Renewable scholarships are awarded for eight consecutive semesters.
