

Technology Committee Meeting, October 24, 2012 –Minutes

Survey of software use: SysAid identifies software implementations. The purchase of Adobe Acrobat will not be pursued.

Online Student Authentication: Elliott reported that the Higher Learning Commission requires that this issue be addressed. Currently, Concord uses Respondus and unique passwords to address authentication. Technology Services staff are evaluating Kryterion and Software Secure authentication software. Elliott asked committee faculty to ask their colleagues about the extent to which they want Technology Services to investigate authentication software and their willingness to review authentication software.

LMS strategy committee: The group will convene soon. J. Pendergast will serve as the representative from Social Sciences.

Electronic library materials: Committee faculty expressed appreciation for the recent establishment of off-campus access to these materials.

Maintenance window: Elliott announced the tentative plan to use the maintenance window on Sunday, Nov. 11 to briefly shut down the data center for rewiring.
