Meeting was called to order at 3:00pm. Draft minutes from last 2 meetings were approved with no corrections. No additional agenda items were raised.

Discussion/Action Items/Updates:

- A) Cyber Security Threats: 2 Major: Specter (Phone and Mobile Devices) and Meltdown (Intel chips going back over 10 years)
Possible slowdown in systems as these threats are addressed programmatically. There is no timeline available to give us an idea of when they will occur. Operating Systems, Applications, and Browsers need to be updated.
- B) Blackboard
247 Blackboard services are now effective. There are some "small bugs" but it is working well.
- C) KnowBe4 security awareness training: new deadline is January 31, 2018. Those not having completed training will be placed on the "high-risk pool."
- D) Zoom video-conferencing: nothing new to report at this time.
