Proposed Agenda:

Agenda Item 1: Agenda was approved.

Agenda Item 2: Changes to previous minutes include changing the name of Kathy Mills to Kathy Reed and adding Debbie Turner to the attendance.

Agenda Item 3: Retirement of legacy Blackboard server. IT is proposing that multiple backups are created and stored in different buildings on campus. Then the server would be taken off line and repositioned for further use. This server has courses going back to Summer 2012. C. Elliot's recommendation is that the voting of this issue be tabled until the next meeting. The working copy will be in Rahall. The second copy will be in the Library. C. Shumate asked the question regarding student concern about the proxy server. C. Elliot sent e-mail to CIOs of state educational facilities and has received no feedback on his request for information. He is continuing to seek this information. Requirements for record maintenance will be explored and investigated further in addressing this action item.

Agenda Item 4: My Pass Update

This inclusion was an error⁴. An update of the My Pass system will occur at the next meeting. J. Yeager discussed with C. Elliott the concern that faculty in his division that were receiving prompts to enter passwords after also changing passwords as required by CU. There was a requirement to update/change the password every 30 days. IT determined that if they entered the administrative password and turn this feature off, it was functioning without problems again.
