

## Technology Committee Meeting Minutes

February 13, 2013, 3:00 pm, Business Division Conference Room

**The proposed Agenda was approved.**

**The minutes of the Nov 14, 2012 meeting were approved.**

**Demonstration: Student Printing.** Representatives from Konica-Minolta provided an overview on managed print services for students. These gentlemen represent multiple products/solutions with varying functionalities. A number of possible requirements were discussed such as requiring authentication, integration with existing systems. It was agreed that the problem is limited in scope and a subcommittee will be formed.

**Administrative Privileges and Exceptions Management.** Elliott briefed the Committee on how limiting the use of Administrative Privileges is an effective security measure and a best practice in place at most universities. However, faculty and employees occasionally require administrative privileges and there should be a process for responding to those requirements. Committee members were asked to share the form with their colleagues and share suggestions and feedback by the next meeting.

**Moodle and Blackboard Status.** Elliott provided an update on the status of Moodle and Blackboard. Concord University now operates two instances of a Learning Management System (LMS), down from five instances last summer.

- The new Moodle instance is accessible at <http://moodle.concord.edu> and is integrated with Active Directory.
- Blackboard Learn 9.1 (service pack 8) is accessible at <http://learn.concord.edu> and is awaiting updating to service pack 11 and integration with Active Directory.

**Timing for applying Blackboard Service Pack 11.** Salifu briefed the Committee on the recent round of faculty workshops designed to familiarize users with Blackboard service pack 11 and Active Directory integration and the post-workshop assessments that indicate attendees are ready now for SP11 and it will not be disruptive to do so mid-semester. ***The Committee approved updating the production instance of Blackboard Learn to service pack 11 and integration with Active Directory.*** This action is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, March 10 which precedes Spring Break.

**Announcements.**

- Quality Matters Training is on the calendar for March 20<sup>th</sup>, 25 attendees are identified.

- Frontier Communications has not provided a start date for the new level of bandwidth at 200 Mbps.
- Technology Services will be proactively reviewing computer labs and technology enhanced classrooms and sharing recommendations with Division Chairs.
- A Search Committee has been formed for the Information Systems Technician position and review of applicants will begin as soon as practical.
