Student cannot have another tuition specific scholarship such as Promise, HSTA, DHHR, U564, or any other scholarships designated for tuition. (2)
<input type="checkbox"/> Joseph Hatcher Scholarship	\$500	Completed Freshman year of college with 24 hours and a 2.5 GPA, be a Mercer County resident (no exceptions) , demonstrate financial need (filed a current year FAFSA), non-renewable scholarship. (2)

Additional Scholarship Criteria:

Applicants are encouraged to demonstrate financial need, have a minimum of 1 year declared as Business Administration, and declared Area of Emphasis, and enrolled as F-T student at CU. One year award, dispersed ½ in the Fall and ½ in the Spring and dependent upon current annual interest rates and state funding.
