Requirements for Admission into Student Teaching

Teacher candidates must apply for admission into student teaching through the Department of Education Office. All applicants must attend on-campus seminars as indicated in the calendar. Admission criteria must be met by the end of the semester prior to student teaching. To be eligible for student teaching, the MAT candidate must meet the following minimum requirements:

1. Completion of a content area transcript analysis, a minimum undergraduate content area 2.75 GPA, successful completion of the GRE/MAT, Praxis II (subject assessment test) prior to full admission into the MAT Program.
2. Completion of all graduate coursework.
3. Attained the required 3.0 GPA for the MAT Program.
4. Attained passing scores on PRAXIS II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) test. Official verification from the testing service must be received in the Department of Education Office prior to the student teaching eligibility deadline. This is also indicated in the admission requirements for student teaching under the MAT Program online at www.concord.edu

NOTE: Verification of fingerprinting and a signed release form for an FBI background check must be submitted with the application for a student teaching permit (WV Form 24) prior to the student teaching semester. Information and forms will be provided during a placement meeting. You will be notified of the meeting date and time by email.
