



#### Q1 - Please indicate your age:






# Q8 - What is your current overall GPA?


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# Q9 - How many semesters did it take you to complete your degree(s):


# Q10 - While at Concord were you a resident, commuter, or both?


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# Q11 - What was your residence at time of admission to Concord University?
