Evening Classes – Athens: Classes meeting at 4:00 PM on Tuesday or Thursday will have a two-hour final beginning at 4:30 PM during the regularly scheduled class meeting time during finals week, DEC 9-13. Classes that start at 4:30 PM or later will have a two-hour final during the regularly scheduled class meeting time during finals week, DEC 9-13. If the two-hour exam block results in a conflict with an exam in a later evening course, the student must notify the professor of the later course and either arrange for a late arrival time or reschedule the exam at the discretion of the professor.

FINAL EXAMS FOR ONLINE CLASSES MUST BE HELD DURING THE SCHEDULED EXAM WEEK.

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE FACULTY:

Any examination for which this schedule does not provide, or any departure from it, must be approved in advance by the Dean of the College, on the request of the instructor made through the department chairperson. Please note that the final exam period is considered when calculating the Carnegie credit hours listed for each course, the observance of which is a requirement of our HLC accreditation; therefore, each course should be able in some way to account for the appropriate time allotted. Final Projects or alternative exams, such as take-home exams, are acceptable, as long as they are approved in advance. Faculty members should also carefully note the deadlines for submission of grades.
