Experience(s) can vary from limited patient interaction to a highly involved hands-on experience. Positions vary in responsibility, so please be descriptive so the faculty reviewers can clearly understand your experience. We do not evaluate the number of hours alone, but also the level of responsibility assigned during your experience.

Above average: a high level of responsibility with many hours of experience.

- > 1000 hours of direct patient care or healthcare experience
- Provided direct patient care with a high level of responsibility in a role such as LPN, RN, medical assistant, paramedic, military medic, CNA, or other licensed medical personnel

Average: a limited degree of responsibility and/or limited hours of experience.

- 500-1000 hours of patient care or healthcare experience
- Provided direct patient care with a limited level of responsibility in a role such as a scribe, phlebotomist, or technician (surgical, dental, optometry, radiology, etc.)

Below average: little to no degree of responsibility with minimal hours of experience.

- Less than 500 hours of patient care or healthcare experience
- No direct patient care with responsibilities in a role such as pharmacy technician, home caregiver, shadowing, hospital volunteer or transporter, or clinical experiences as a student

*The types of direct patient care experiences listed above are not exhaustive. Applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
