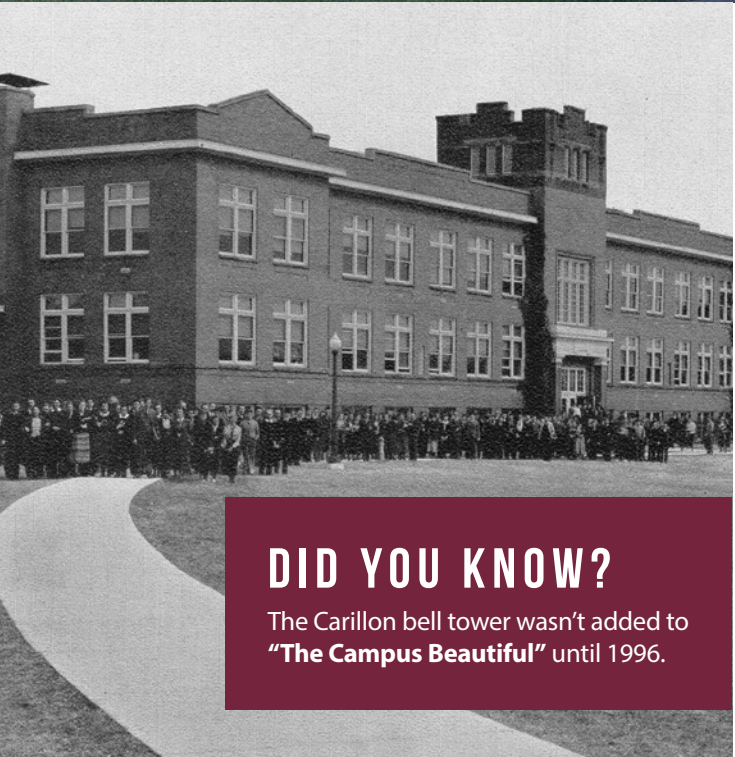

Concord University and the area surrounding campus are the very definition of Wild and Wonderful West Virginia.

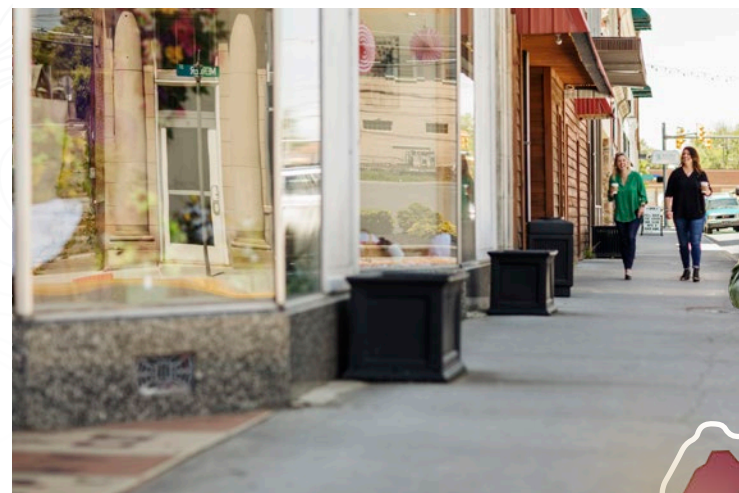
As a student, you are a short distance from Pipestem State Park's zipline experience and the Pipestem Splash Park & Adventure Lake. Our students receive special rates and programs!

We're nestled in the heart of the Appalachian Mountains, with easy access to I-77. Princeton, WV is a short 15 minute drive, Blacksburg, VA can be reached in an hour and Charlotte, NC in less than 3 hours!

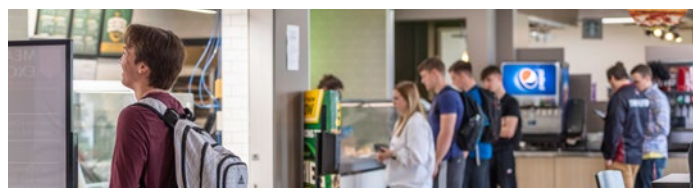

CREATING YOUR OWN SPACE Starts with *YOU!*

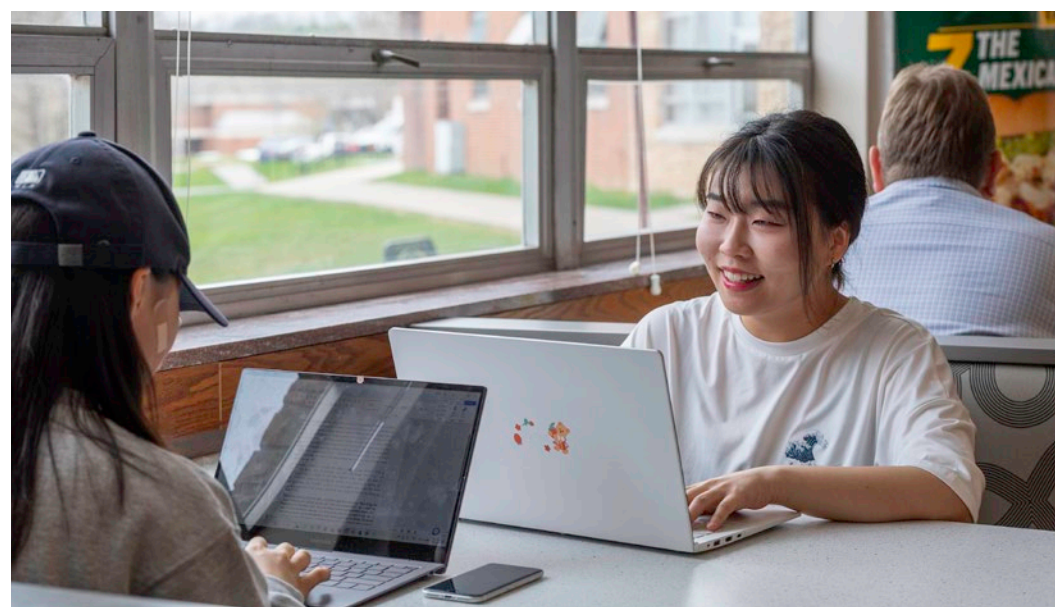
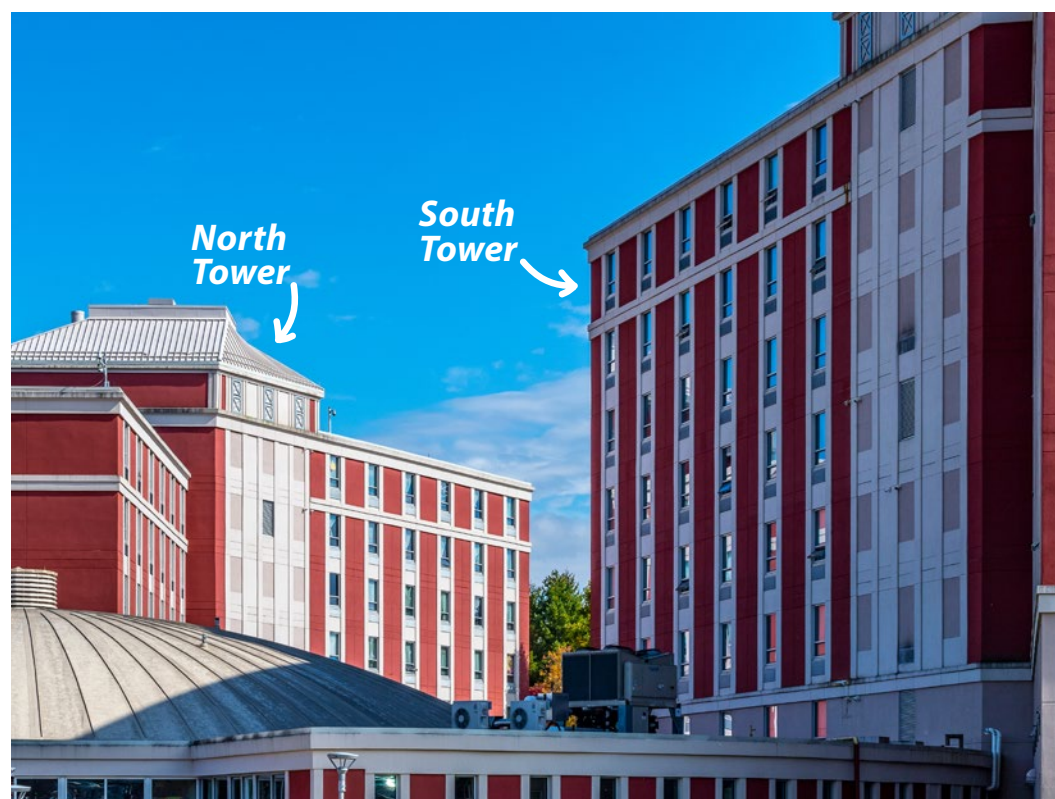
One meaningful part of the college experience is living on campus. Residence hall living is a chance to meet new people and create lifelong friendships.

By becoming a Mountain Lion, our student athletes commit to representing Concord University as ambassadors and role models to students, staff, faculty, and the entire university community.

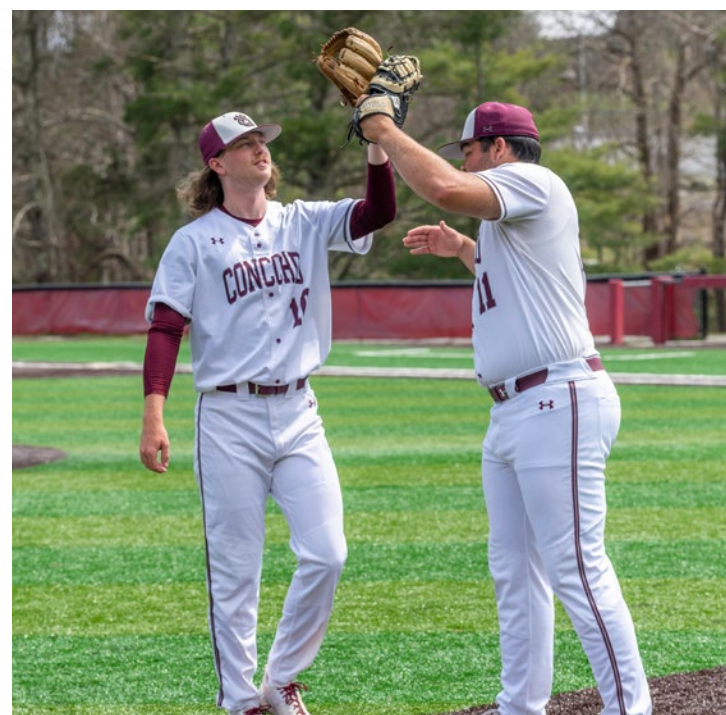
