1	What is the job
	shadowing program?

This program is a short-term career exploration experience that allows you to spend a day (or part of a day) observing a professional in your field of interest. This is a great way to learn about different careers, industries, and workplace environments.

2 Why should I participate?

Job shadowing can help you: explore possible career paths, gain real-world insight outside of the classroom, connect with professionals, strengthen your resume, and build confidence in your career decisions.

3 How do I sign up?

- Choose "Job Shadow Program Appointment under Career Services
- Complete survey and upload resume

4 What happens at the appointment?

We will review your resume and provide feedback. After, we will explain how the program works and discuss your interests and goals. We will then explore potential job shadow matches.

5 **Do I need a resume?**
