You would answer "Yes" if you:

• can provide a copy of a court's decision that, as of today, you are in legal guardianship or are an emancipated minor; or if you can provide a copy of a court's decision that you were in legal guardianship immediately before you reached the age of being an adult in your state.

You would answer "No" if:

- you are still a minor and the court decision is no longer in effect, or if the court decision was not in effect at the time you turned 18. OR
- custody was awarded by the courts and court papers say custody (not quardianship).
