**Mercer County, WV** – Twenty-two schools and five school districts are celebrating National GEAR UP Week from September 25 through September 29 this year. The week commemorates the continuing success of Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (GEAR UP), a college access program providing students and families the support and resources they need for college access and success.

Schools are also planning activities to celebrate the program. Students attending Road Branch Elementary can participate in "Student Selfie Days." Students at this Wyoming County school should dress for daily college and career themes next week. From your favorite college to sunglasses to a future self, the activities will encourage students to think about their future and see success.
