

1. What date is graduation?

4. Where do I order my cap and gown?

Your cap and gown were ordered by the bookstore based on your answers from the Intent to Participate Form. Students who requested that their cap and gown be mailed to them will be contacted by the bookstore for postage payment. An email will be sent to all students when the cap and gowns are ready to be picked up.

5. Do I need tickets for my guests?

No, students will not be required to have tickets for the May ceremonies. Seats are on a first come first serve basis, bleacher style seating.
