1) Welcome

Amanda Sauchuck opened the meeting by thanking members for attending and acknowledging the difficulty of finding a time that worked for everyone.

2) Program Assessment Plans (Due April 2026)

- Amanda reviewed the purpose of the Program Assessment Plan template, noting it was designed from the *Assessment Handbook* and complements (but is separate from) the annual assessment process.
- The plan is intended to help programs map out assessment efforts in advance, removing guesswork.
- All Program Assessment Plans are due in April 2026.
- Discussion on future deadlines:
 - o Members agreed the plan should not be submitted annually but only when updates are necessary.
 - o Consensus: Plans should be updated and resubmitted on the same schedule as the 5-year program reviews. If no changes have occurred, nothing further would be required.

3) Supporting the Culture of Assessment

- Members were asked to bring back feedback from their departments about needs and supports that would strengthen assessment work.
- John Makous suggested continuing CTL workshops on "What is Assessment?" for both new and experienced faculty.

4) Five-Year Program Reviews and Annual Assessment Reports

- Reminder: Annual and 5-Year reports are due November 1.
- All reports have been initiated in CAPS except for Data Analytics and Education.
- Education is currently the only program undergoing a 5-year review. Amanda is working with Andrea to ensure materials are completed.
- Faculty were asked to notify Amanda if they encounter issues within CAPS.

5) CTL Workshops

- Upcoming sessions:

7) HLC Criterion Changes

- Amanda reviewed recent HLC Criterion updates related to assessment:
 - o 3.E. Assessment of Student Learning Institutions must show program improvements based on assessment.
 - o 3.F. Program Review Institutions must improve curriculum through periodic review.
 - 3.G. Student Success Outcomes Institutions must demonstrate continuous improvement in student success outcomes, considering student demographics and peer benchmarks.
